1. Kumite Categories #1-56

A) Children "Soft Class": Divisions #1-4

The "Soft Class" is for students at entry and intermediate levels. A student who enters this category must have at least one tournament experience in their country.

- Divisions #1-A to #3-F are Boys & Girls mixed divisions.
- Division #4-A and #4-B are only Girls divisions.
- Division #1-A is for students born between April 2nd 2017 and 2020, who have very little tournament experience.
- Students born between April 2nd 2017 and 2020, who placed 1st or 2nd of the Division #1-B in 2022, are not allowed to enter the same division. They must move up to the "Champion Class" this year.
- Students born between April 2nd 2011 and April 1st 2017, who placed 1st or 2nd of the Division #2-A to #2-F in 2022, must move up to the Division 3-A to 3-F or "Champion Class" this year regardless of their belt color.
- Students born between April 2nd 2011 and April 1st 2017, who placed 1st or 2nd of the Division #3-A to #3-F in 2022, must move up the "Champion Class" this year.
- Students born between April 2nd 2011 and April 1st 2015, who have placed 1st or 2nd of the Division #4-A or Division #4-B in 2022, must move up to the "Champion Class"
- In case that the number of entries reached 11 or more, the division will be divided into two weight categories. A cut-off weight will be an average weight calculated from the total weight of competitors.
- Multiple divisions may be jointed together in case that the number of entries did not reach four.
- The protective gear below is mandatory for all "Soft Class" divisions. Refer to the IKO Nakamura Protective Gear Guideline for our standardized gear.
 - -Head Gear -Groin Cup for Boys -Body/Chest Pad -Gloves -Shin/Instep Pad

B) Children "Champion Class": Divisions #5-6

The "Champion Class" is for students at advanced levels who have fought and placed 1st to 3rd at national and international tournaments. They should have enough experience to compete internationally.

Important Notes

- Please refer to the Protective Gear Guideline for the mandatory gear of each division.
- For Division #27 to #45, an older and/or lower belt student can sign up for a higher division. For example, a 43-year-old orange belt lightweight fighter can fight in the Division #27 instead of #31
- For Division #46 to #56, a fighter born between Apr 2, 2005 and Apr 1, 2008 can enter these adults' divisions with branch chief's approval.
- Multiple divisions may be jointed together in case that the number of entries did not reach three. When this happens, the related Branch Chiefs and HDDOs will be notified of the combined divisions. Then, they have to make a decision and let Honbu know by October 15 whether they accept the combined division or withdraw their fighters from the tournament.
- A division which only has three fighters will have a match to determine 2nd place.
- If any of these divisions has only one entry from overseas, the fighter's branch chief or HDDO will be notified after September 30. Then, they are required to make a decision and let Honbu know by October 15 whether they want to withdraw from the tournament or they want Honbu to move the fighter to other division.
- The tournament draws will be determined on November 10. After this date, we cannot make any changes in match-ups because Honbu will forward them to a printing company on November 11.
- A weigh-in will be conducted either on the tournament day or the day before the tournament.
- Competitors will be disqualified by the weight discrepancies described below.
 - If his or her weight at the weigh-in exceeds the limit of the weight category they have registered, the competitor will be disqualified.
 - If his or her weight at the weigh-in is lighter or heavier by more than 5kg from their registered weight, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Please do not choose a weight category that forces your fighter to lose too much weight. To a team representative: Please advise your competitors, underage students in particular, to select an appropriate weight division according to their <u>natural</u> weights.
